Some Important Tips!

- Grantors do not fund personnel, equipment, supplies, travel, and other expenses
- Grantors do fund outcomes and deliverables related to their Mission and funding priorities
- Grantors will pay for expenses that help you achieve their preferred outcomes & deliverables, such as salaries for personnel, stipends for consultants, equipment, supplies, travel, etc.

What Grants Can Do for You! **PERSONNEL & SALARIES**

- Reassigned time for fulltime faculty
- Support staff salaries (PAs, College/Student Aides)
- Fringe benefits associated with f/t or p/t salaries
- SCCC grants that fund Personnel & Salaries:
 - Title III-A SEIS grant
 TRIO-SSS (Student Support Services) grant
 CTEA Major Effort projects

What Grants Can Do for You! EQUIPMENT & SUPPLIES

Supplies (usually < \$5,000 each)</p>

- State-of-the-art Equipment (> \$5,000 each)
- No supplanting!

SCCC grants that fund Equipment & Supplies:

Title III-A SEIS grant
 ARRA-NYSERDA grants (boilers/energy-efficiency)
 CTEA Major Effort projects

What Grants Can Do for You! PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT

- Travel to conferences Domestic / International
- Funds to develop workshops & host conferences
 Faculty salaries / Consulting fees
- Stipends for faculty, high school teachers and/or other workshop participants
- SCCC grants that fund Professional Development:
 - NSF-ATE grant
 Title III-A SEIS grant
 CTEA Major Effort projects

What Grants Can Do for You! STUDENT SCHOLARSHIPS

- Scholarships for low income students (S-STEM)
- Scholarships for special groups (TRIO / STEM)
- Support stipends for fees, books, supplies
- SCCC grants that fund Student Scholarships:
 - NSF S-STEM Program grant
 - TRIO-SSS Program grant
 - Collegiate Science & Technology Program (CSTEP)
 - Educational Opportunity Program (EOP) grant

What Grants Can Do for You! CURRICULAR REVISIONS

- Faculty reassigned time & salaries for p/t staff
- New software, computer hardware, etc.
- Funds to hire external consultants
- SCCC grants that fund Curricular Revisions:
 - Title III-A SEIS grant
 - NSF-ATE grant
 - CTEA Major Effort projects

What Grants Can Do for You! RESEARCH SUPPORT

- Faculty reassigned time & support staff salaries
- Equipment, supplies, software, etc.
- Funds for consultants, conference travel, etc.
- Grantors that provide Research Support:
 - National League for Nursing (nursing)
 National Endowment for the Humanities (humanities)
 U.S. Dept. of State-Fulbright Program (various)
 National Science Program (engineering & sciences)

What Grants Cannot Do for You! UNALLOWABLE EXPENDITURES

Unallowable expenditures almost always include:

- Furniture, carpets & other furnishings (exceptions = ramps and furniture for the disabled)
- Food, beverages, liquor (exceptions = food for conference participants)

Items that "supplant" normal college expenditures (exceptions = state-of-the-art equipment; supplies & equipment for newly renovated labs)

Anything that is an "institutional responsibility" (examples = administrative staff time)

How to Enhance Your Grants Success at SCCC

Conduct in-house research; do a pilot study Author a small grant, e.g., CTEA major effort Participate as grantwriting team member Offer to help with a colleague's grant project Serve as a Co-PI/Co-PD on another grant Talk to program officers about your ideas Volunteer as an agency proposal reviewer 8 Ask the SCCC Grants Office staff for advice!
