

## Prerequisite Guidelines for Non-Degree Students

The following can be used for satisfying prerequisite requirements:

- College transcripts showing courses with a grade of C or better will allow students to register for classes that require these courses as prerequisites.
- Advanced placement tests with scores of 3 or higher will substitute for corresponding college-level courses and can be used for satisfying prerequisite requirements for classes requiring these courses. (See the following link for AP courses and their corresponding equivalents at SCCC:

- College transcripts showing successful completion of upper-level developmental courses, equivalent to SCCC's RDG099, ENG010 or MAT007, will allow students to register for classes that require these courses as prerequisites.
- The following tests and scores will allow placement in college-level math courses, MAT101–MAT112:

SAT math score of 510 or higher  
ACT math score of 22 or higher  
Math B Regents score of 85 or higher

- The following tests and scores will allow placement in ENG101 Standard Freshman Composition:  
  
SAT verbal score of 500 or higher  
ACT reading score of 21 or higher  
English Regents score of 85 or higher
- If no documentation is available for a reading, English or mathematics prerequisite, the college placement test (Accuplacer) will be administered to determine appropriate placements.
- High school transcripts with foreign language courses can be used as a guide for placement into foreign language classes. (For *Foreign Language Placement Guidelines*, see the following link:
