

## NEW YORK STATE HIGH SCHOOL EQUIVALENCY DIPLOMA

Students can earn a high school equivalency diploma by successfully completing 24 college credits, as follows:

<b><u>ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS:</u></b> Six credits (i.e., two courses in composition, literature, speech, and/or creative writing)	_____	6
<b><u>HUMANITIES:</u></b> Three credits (i.e., one course in literature, foreign language, art history, art appreciation, music, music appreciation, theatre, philosophy, religion)	_____	3
<b><u>MATHEMATICS:</u></b> Six credits (i.e., two courses in math, calculus, statistics, business math and/or technical math)	_____	6
<b><u>NATURAL SCIENCE:</u></b> Three credits (i.e., one course in biology, chemistry, physics, earth science, geology, botany, or zoology)	_____	3
<b><u>SOCIAL SCIENCE:</u></b> Three credits (i.e., one course in history, sociology, psychology, economics, political science, or labor studies)	_____	3
<b><u>CAREER AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION AND/OR FOREIGN LANGUAGE:</u></b> Three credits (i.e., one course in such areas as agriculture, business and marketing, family and consumer science, technology, trade/industrial arts, etc. Also includes such areas as nutrition, studio art, home economics, theatre design, computer technology, computer science, physical/health education, first aid/CPR, foreign language, sign language, etc.) Note: excludes college seminar, career planning, PE activity courses	_____	3
