In order to qualify for a medical exemption from immunizations required by Section 2165 of the New York Stat Public Health Law, your physician must complete this exemption form and the completed form must be returned to the Healt Services office on your home campus.
Students should bring to the Health Services office any previous immunizations, a physician-verified diagnosis of measles or mumps disease, and/or positive titer results. The titer is a blood test which determines the level of immunity a individual may have to measles, mumps or rubella. Positive titer results are an alternative to immunizations.
If an outbreak of measles, mumps or rubella should occur on campus, you may be considered susceptible under the New York State Public Health Law, and may be required to remain off campus until the Suffolk County Department of Health deems it safe for you to return. <i>These absences may cause you to be withdrawn from your classes</i> . Immunization records of titer results may fulfill the immunization requirements and prevent exclusion from the campus in the event of an outbreak
