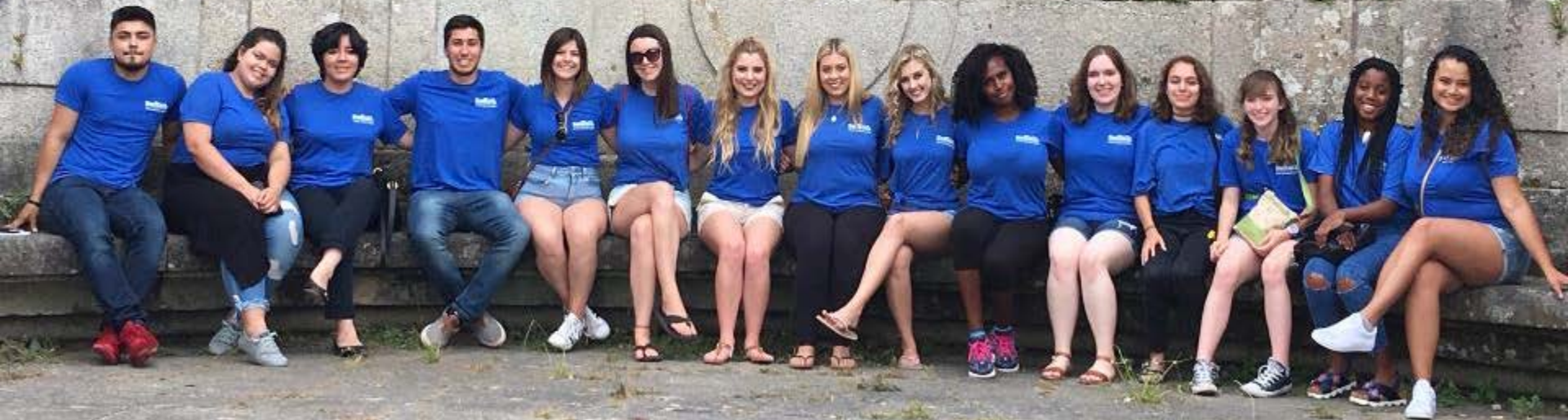

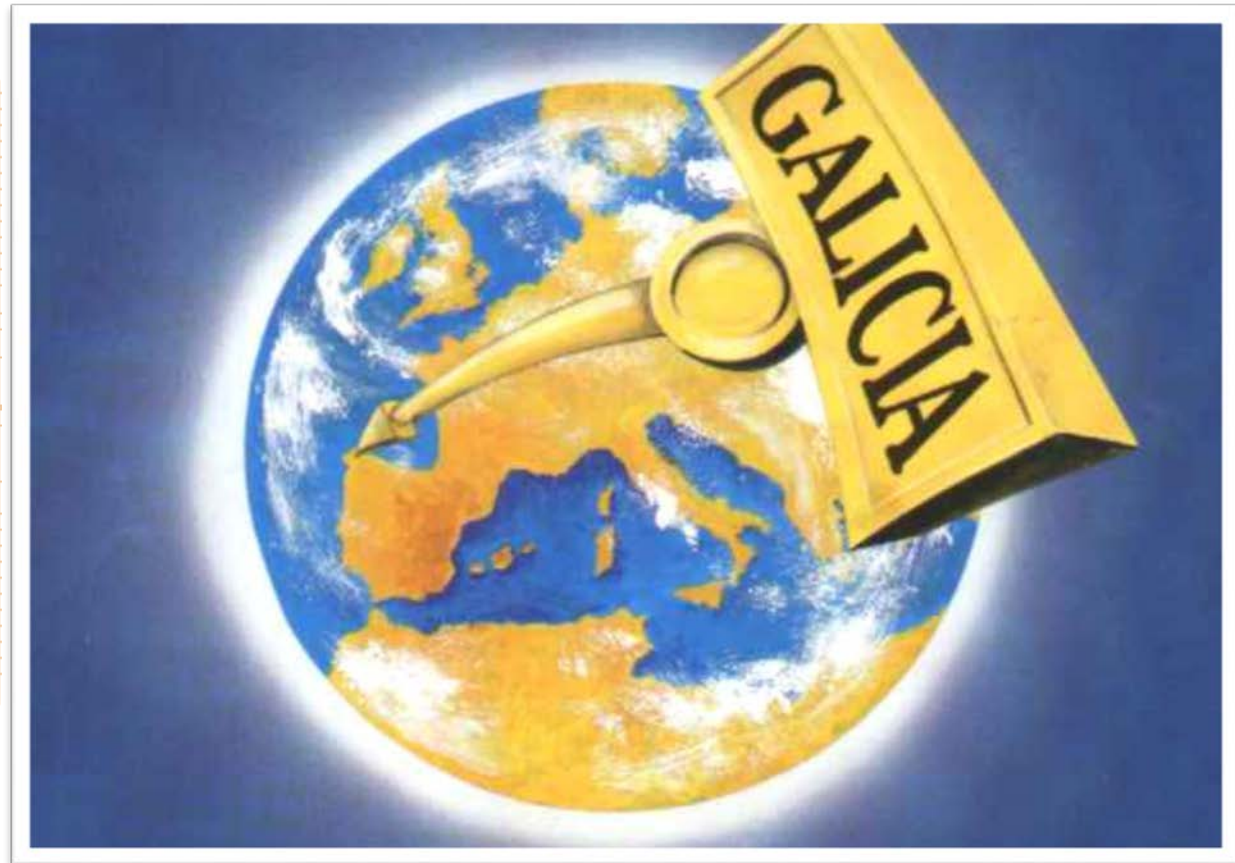

## *Why should I participate in this program?*

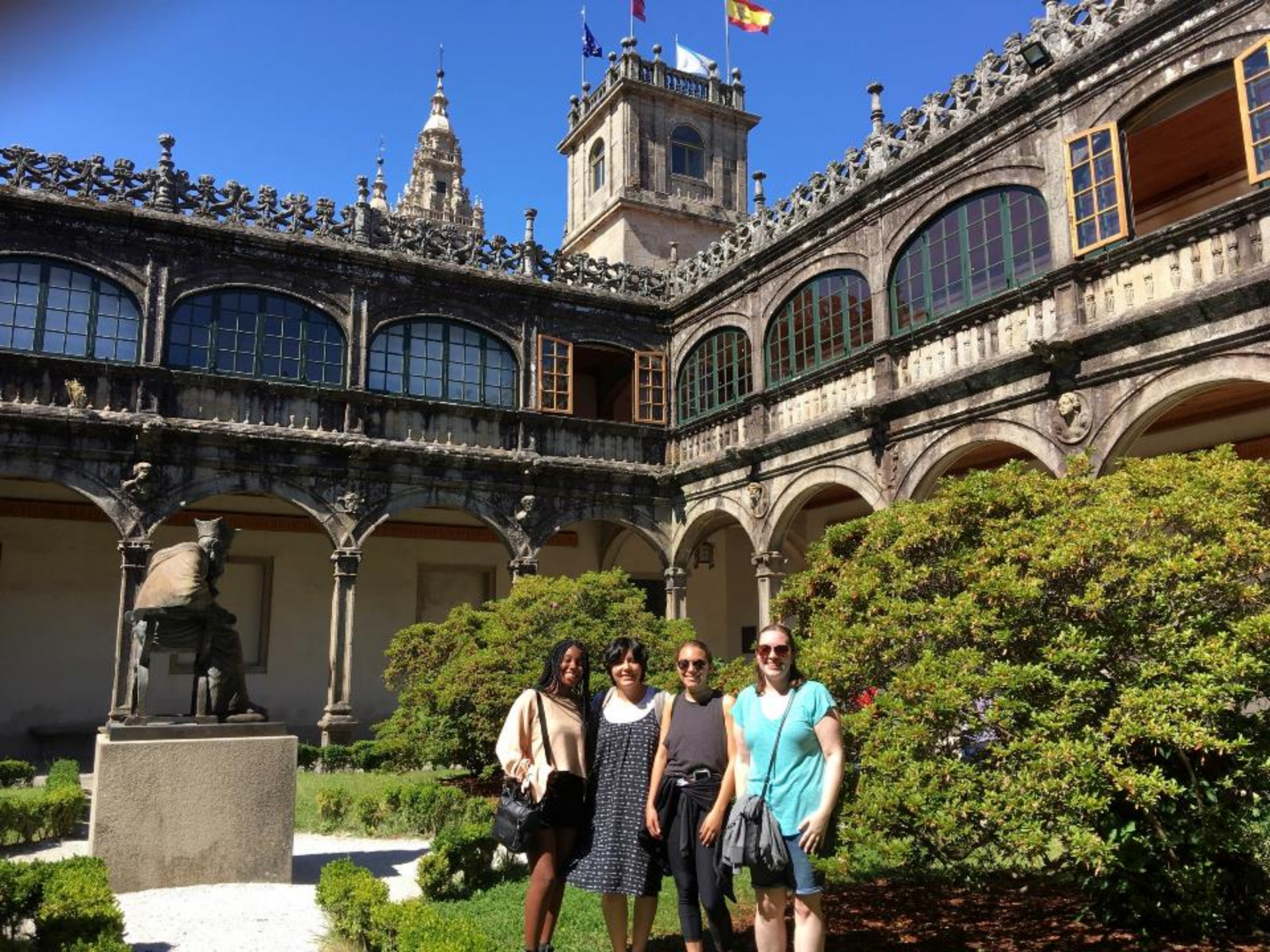

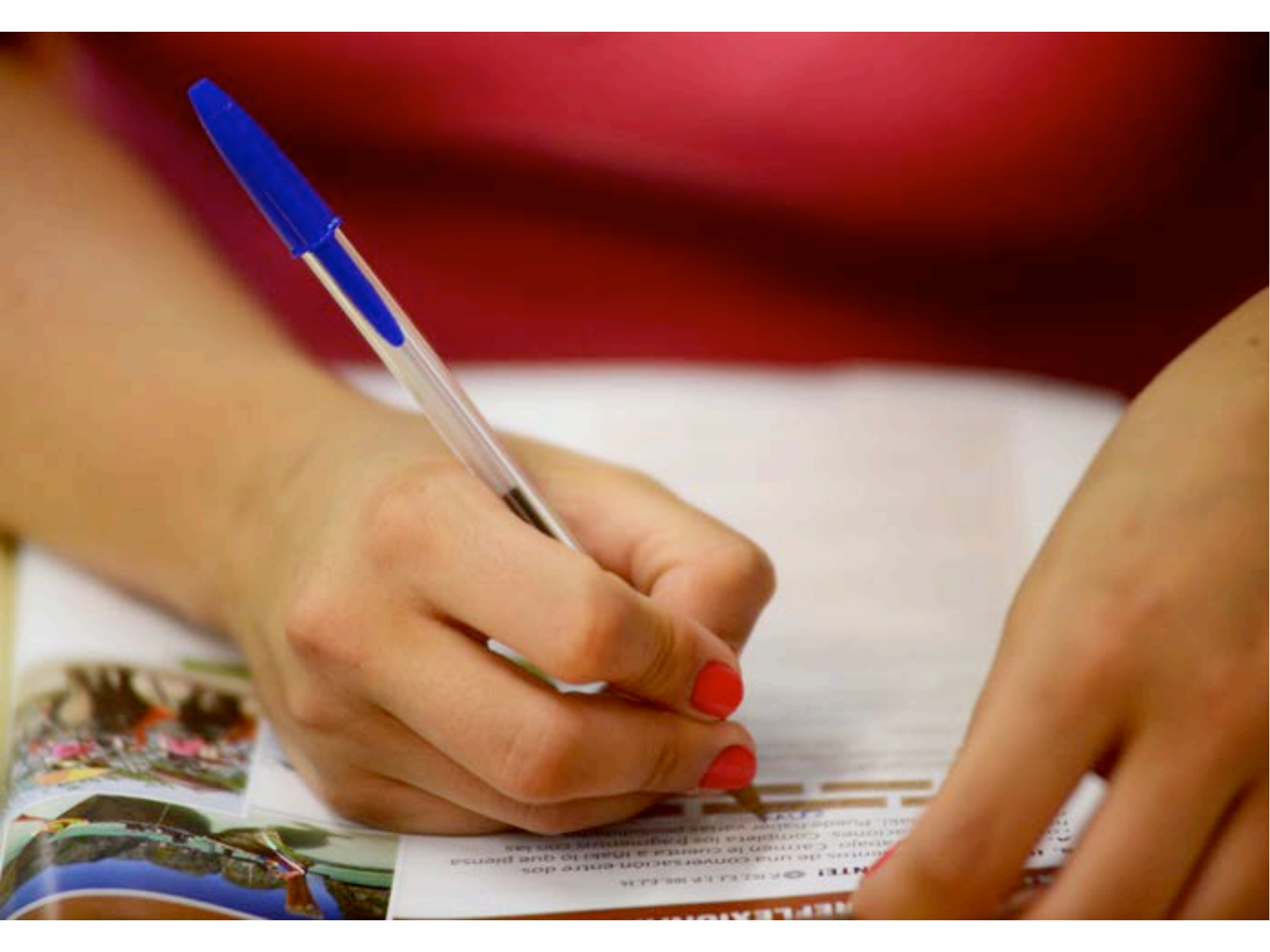
