Dear Student,

New York State enacted a law allowing non-residents and non-resident aliens to pay single tuition if they meet certain conditions.

If you have:

- ◆ Attended an approved NYS high school for at least two (2) years and graduated from an approved NYS high school, or have received a NYS General Equivalency Diploma after attending a NYS approved GED program

and

- ◆ Have applied for attendance at an institution or educational unit of the State University of New York within five (5) years of receiving a NYS high school diploma or GED

You may qualify for single tuition.

In order for this reduction in tuition to be made, you must bring proof of your legal status; for example, a resident alien card (green card) or a current visa. If, however, you are without lawful immigration status, you must present a notarized copy of the attached affidavit stating that you have, or will as soon as possible, file an application to legalize your immigration status. Please note that this must be notarized before presenting it to the Office of Admissions on your campus.

Once you have presented the required documentation, a determination of your eligibility will be made and your tuition will be adjusted appropriately.
