## Exceptions to Income Guidelines:

1. The student's family is the recipient of Family Assistance or Safety Net payments through the New York State Office of Temporary and Disability Assistance; or through a county Department of Social Services; or Family Day Care payments through the New York State Office of Children and Family Assistance.
2. The student lives with foster parents who do not provide support for college and the student's natural parents provide no such support.
3. The student is a ward of the state or county.

## Required Records

As part of the EOP admission process, your high school record and test scores (if needed) will be reviewed, as well as information about clubs, hobbies, jobs and any other experiences that have made an impact on your education. This information will help counselors evaluate your potential for success in a college-level program.

## Transfers

You are eligible for EOP as a transfer student provided you have been enrolled in EOP, College Discovery, HEOP (Higher Education Opportunity Program), SEEK (Search for Education, Elevation and Knowledge) or a similar academic and financial support program at your previous college. If your previous college did not have EOP or a similar program, you may be considered for transfer eligibility and should notify Suffolk of your interest.
