

Dear Student,

The College has continued to advocate for students to have access to the COVID-19 vaccine. Interim College President Louis Petrizzo has been advised that the State has reserved a small shipment of the Johnson & Johnson COVID-19 vaccine for use in vaccinating SUNY Suffolk students over the age of 18. Because this vaccine requires just one dose, you will not need to make a second appointment. Supplies are extremely limited. Please note that vaccination is not mandatory for students at this time.

If you know you would like to be vaccinated and want to schedule a vaccination appointment right away, you should immediately send an email to this address: [myturn@sunysuffolk.edu](mailto:myturn@sunysuffolk.edu) indicating your contact information (cell phone number and college email address). In response, a representative from the College will call you during business hours to schedule an appointment for you to receive the one-dose Johnson & Johnson COVID-19 vaccine.

Please note that the College will continue to work with the State in securing additional vaccine supplies over the next several weeks. Should we distribute all of the original allocation of vaccine, the College will implement a waiting list and you will be notified of the next round of vaccinations.
