GUIDELINES FOR POLITICAL CAMPAIGNING ON CAMPUS

APPLICABILITY

These guidelines relate to persons campaigning for public political office and do not apply to campaigning for positions within the College community.

ADVERTISING

In order to preserve the appearance of the campus and avoid damage to the buildings, posters promoting the candidacy of any individual shall not be permitted. Posters announcing debates, meetings or speeches shall be permitted. Leaflets shall not be handed to students but may be made available to students by depositing them in locations approved by the Director of Student Activities.

E OF FACILITIES

The use of classroom, lounge or other limited access area will only be permitted under the following circumstances:

- 1. The area has been approved by the Executive Dean.
- The candidate was invited by an approved campus organization.
- 3. Each major party candidate for the particular office was invited in a timely manner.

CAMPAIGNING IN COMMON AREAS

Candidates may campaign in lobby or outdoor areas but no College equipment will be provided. The campaigning must be confined to areas or times to ensure that classroom or other activities will not be disrupted. The use of sound trucks, amplifiers or other distracting activities will not be permitted.
