RESOLUTION NO. 90.113 ESTABLISHING A POLICY ON PROFESSIONAL STAFF MEMBERS SERVING ON ACCREDITATION TEAMS

WHEREAS, the Middle States Association of Schools and Colleges, the State Education Department, and other accrediting and reviewing bodies depend upon professional educators to constitute teams sent on institutional visits, and

WHEREAS, faculty and administrators at Suffolk Community College are periodically invited to serve on such teams, and

WHEREAS, Suffolk Community College benefits from the experiences of its faculty and administrators in serving on visiting teams, and

WHEREAS, service as a visiting team member is performed for nominal consideration, be it therefore

RESOLVED, That faculty and administrators be excused from regular duties for up to three days per year to serve as part of an accreditation or similar institutional review team, provided that the President of the College has given prior approval of such activity.
