Common Scholarship Myths: Busted!

I can't receive a scholarship because...

- I'm not a "straight A" student.
- My tuition is already covered by financial aid or other resources.
- My parents make too much money.
- I am not a U.S. citizen.
- I am a U.S. veteran or active in the military and attend college for free.
- I attend a community college.
- I am not eligible for financial aid or haven't filed a FAFSA.




Getting Started

- If you would like to apply for any scholarships, you must have your SCCC login and password available
- Sign into the Online Scholarship System
- Select the Sign In With Your Institution box

- Choose whether you are a New Student or Continuing Student






1. Enter your MySCCC username and password

Are you a new or continuing student? Select "New Student"




3. Complete the New Student Application step.





Search for Scholarship Opportunities




Visit the **OPPORTUNITIES**tab and select **OURS** to
