The Suffolk Community College Foundation awards more than \$500,000 in scholarships for new, continuing and graduating Suffolk students.

The Suffolk Community College Foundation raises money to:

- I attend a community college.
- I am not eligible for financial aid or haven't filed a FAFSA.

To apply for any of the College's online scholarships, you need to **be 'accepted' to SUNY Suffolk and** have your student username and password.







Presidential Scholarship for New Students

Awarded to: Full-time NEW students
Award: Full tuition and fees, plus a \$250 book allowance (three awards – one from each campus)
Criteria:

1. High School average of 90 or better (non-weighted in Regents Diploma Program)
2. Top ten percent of graduating class
3. Evidence of leadership skills or community service
4. Three letters of recommendation from guidance, faculty, and school or community service agency, providing leadership recommendation

Scholarships are renewable for three semesters provided the student maintains a 3.2 GPA and full-time enrollment.

1. Please demonstrate your commitment to leadership and/or community service by listing and describing your participation in specific activities. Please include the length of time you were involved in each activity.
2. Please request a letter of recommendation from your guidance counselor.
3. Please request a letter of recommendation from a community service reference.
4. Please request a third letter of recommendation supporting your commitment to leadership and/or community service.

The DEADLINE for NEW student scholarships is April 23, 2021.

You can edit your scholarship applications until the deadline.

When you have completed a semester at SUNY Suffolk, continue to apply for scholarships as a CONTINUING student.
