



## **NSF S-STEM APPLICATION**

Scholarship Program for Students Majoring in Science, Engineering, Computer Science, Information Technology, or Mathematics

Suffolk County Community College, in conjunction with the National Science Foundation, will award approximately 30 NSF-STEM scholarships to full-time students with a minimum GPA of 2.7 who meet NSF/federal eligibility requirements; STEM scholarship recipients must remain enrolled full time in an approved STEM discipline.

### **Eligibility:**

1. You must be enrolled at Suffolk County Community College, or if you are an entering student, you must provide an official high school transcript showing your weighted GPA. Current SCCC students will be accepted into the program based on a review of their SCCC transcripts.
2. You must declare a major in one of the following disciplines: biology, biotechnology, chemistry, earth/space science, environmental science, geosciences, meteorology, physics, computer science, information technology, engineering science, electrical technology, construction technology, or mathematics.
3. You must complete this application.
4. You must submit two letters of recommendation from individuals most acquainted with your academic ability and achievement (e.g., teacher, counselor, employer).
5. You must apply for financial aid by filing a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). See SCCC Financial Aid - Applying for Aid.
